Top of the Rock – 30 Rockefeller Plaza- enter on 50th St between 5th & 6th Ave (212) 698-2000

360-degree views of NYC from indoor & outdoor observation decks 70 floors up at the top of 30 Rock; TICKET REQUIRED

The Rink at Rockefeller Center – Rockefeller Plaza between 49th and 50th St (212) 771-7200

Ice skate (TICKET REQUIRED) or just watch the skaters at this iconic outdoor rink.

Rockefeller Center Christmas Tree – 30 Rockefeller Plaza *2024 tree lighting is on December 4th

Rockefeller Center Tour – 30 Rockefeller Plaza (877) 692-7625

75-minute guided tour to learn about the history, art and architecture and see points of interest; TICKETS REQUIRED

NBC Studios Tour – 30 Rockefeller Plaza- entrance on 6th Avenue, between 49th & 50th St (212) 664-3700

90-minute guided tour of NBC television and news studios; TICKETS REQUIRED (closed Mon- Wed.)

Holiday Windows – Check out the holiday window displays of stores along 5th Avenue and at Rockefeller Plaza

St. Patrick's Cathedral – 5th Avenue between E 50th and 51st Street (212) 664-3700

Stop in to view this beautiful cathedral or take an official 50-minute self-guided audio tour

Diamond District – Check out the gemstones along 47th Street between 5th and 6th Avenues
